### **OPERATION BLUE ROOF**

The U.S. Amry Corps of Engineers has opened Operation Blue Roof in Hardee County through Tuesday, November 5, 2024. This program is a free service for homeowners and permanently occupied rental properties, providing fiber-reinforced, industrial strength sheeting to protect stormdamaged roofs until homeowners can make permanent repairs. ### Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA)

DUA is available for weeks of unemployment beginning October 6, 2024, through April 12, 2025, as long as the individual's unemployment continues to be a result of the disaster in the designated-disaster areas. The deadline to submit a claim for DUA benefits is no later than December 10, 2024.

To file a claim, go to www.FloridaJobs.org and select "File a Claim", visit a local CareerSource Career Center, or call 1-800-385-3920. Customer service representatives are available Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. For DUA claims information, call 1-833-FL-APPLY (1-833-352-7759) to speak with a representative.
